

# PENNY AND FOOD/NECESSITIES DRIVE 2024

Sponsored by the Eighth Grade Class at MBS

The Eighth Grade Class is sponsoring a community service project that will benefit multiple organizations, including The Beaver County Humane Society, The First Baptist Church of Midland, The Center, and Midland families this holiday season by providing gift, food, and monetary donations. The eighth-grade class is requesting that students participate in a penny/necessity drive between Tuesday, December 3 and Monday, December 9. Homerooms receive "points" based on the amount of pennies/necessities brought in. Homerooms will compete to bring in the most "points", and the winning homerooms will be treated to a classroom party.

## PENNY DRIVE

- Students are requested to donate pennies as they compete against other homerooms to earn the most points throughout the week (**silver coins/bills also accepted!**).

## NONPERISHABLE FOOD/NECESSITIES DRIVE

- Students are requested to donate nonperishable food items and other necessities during the drive. All items may be brought in any time during the five-day drive and are worth 5 points *unless* they are brought in on a "Double Point Day" which is indicated below.

**\*\*\*NOTE: We can only accept new, store-packaged items. Items must not be expired.**

### Double Point Days (10 Points each item)

- **Tuesday, December 3: Pet Items** (dog & cat toys, soft dog treats, peanut butter, dish soap)
- **Wednesday, December 4: Paper/Plastic Products** (paper towels, toilet paper, facial tissue, napkins, 13 gallon garbage bags, gallon Ziploc bags)
- **Thursday, December 5: Individual Snack Items** (mac and cheese cups, Chef Boyardee cups, individually wrapped snacks such as granola bars, chips, crackers, drink boxes/pouches, etc)
- **Friday, December 6: Can and Box Food Items** (any nonperishable can or box food items)
- **Monday, December 9: Personal Care Items** (body lotion, body wash, shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrushes)
